Article I, Section 1: Associations shall mean any and all member Organizations.

Article IV, Section 2: Change to read; "3/5 of the Board members, two (2) of which shall be of the Executive Committee, shall constitute a quorum."

Article IV, Section 4: Strike the words, "in second Saturday of February."

Article IV: Add Section 5: Officers shall assume the offices at the end of the Annual Meeting.

Article VII, Section 3: Notify the Board Members not more than thirty (30) days nor less than ten (10) days and present an agenda of the proposed meeting of the Board.

- 31.** (Minutes March 10, 2001) The Kansas Antique Engine Show Safety Association (KAESSA) hereby incorporates the KAESSA Boiler Safety Rules and Regulations as an integral part of the association bylaws. Beginning with Revision 1, March 2001, any and all corrections, revisions, additions and deletions shall be incorporated in that document by means of Article VII, Section 2 of the Constitution: a majority vote. Effective this date, bylaws #5, #9, #10, #11 (except Constitutional Amendment), #12A&B, #13A&B (except Constitutional Amendments), #14, #15, #16, #17, #18, #20, #21, #22, #24, #26, #27 and #28 are repealed and such content incorporated in the KAESSA Boiler Safety Rules and Regulations.
